Introduced in 2010 to offer a fuller-flavoured, more traditional version of shiraz to the popular Wild Oats Shiraz Viognier, this wine offers concentrated dark fruits on a richer, weightier palate.

Fresh, crisp and fruit driven, they have captured the minds of wine lovers, perhaps for no other reason than their suitability to our warm climate and light, vibrant cuisine.

Wild Oats Shiraz is a supple, rounded Shiraz with appealing plummy fruits and a touch of spice.

### Winemaking notes:

Individual parcels were fermented at moderate temperatures and gently extracted for 10-14 days prior to pressing. The wine was then run into a combination of older French and some American oak for 18 months maturation prior to blending and bottling.
